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STATISTICIAN'S NOTE

With the addition of Cretin, Hill-Murray and St. Thomas (and with Monroe no longer a senior high), the conference played a different amount of games (34 more) than were played last season.

For this reason, it is impossible to compare this season's stats with those of last year. I, therefore, was forced to compute the average statistic from last season and multiply that number to create a total that could be used for comparison. Seasonal increases or decreases that have been affected are denoted with an asterisk ().*
