A special commendation is due Highland Park's "B" Coach Bill Paddock. After his Scots finished last in 1977-1978 with a 2-16 record, Bill's Highland Park team "turned the tables" this season posting a conference winning 17-1 record. Bill's "B" Bombers then went out and won the Twin Cities "B" Championship. Congratulations, Bill!

FAREWELL MURRAY AND WASHINGTON

This season marks the end of competition for two conference teams, Murray and Washington. The combining of the two schools should help the athletic squads of the new Como Park Senior High.

Murray High School has compiled a 181-254 record in its 435 conference games. The Pilots scored 19,217 points and allowed 20,714 points. Murray began City Conference play on December 15, 1939 (when the Pilots lost to Mechanic Arts 41-22). The Pilots were involved in 16 overtime games (winning seven of them). Murray won one outright City Conference basketball championship (1970) and shared four titles: in 1944 (with Washington); in 1957 (with Wilson); in 1971 (with Mechanic Arts); and in 1972 (with Highland Park). Murray produced one conference scoring champion, Robert Lewis (1977).

Washington amassed a 190-342 record in its 532 conference games. The President's scored 20,360 points and allowed 23,804. The Prexies played their first conference game on February 3, 1928 (losing to Johnson 54-11). Washington has played in 30 overtime games, winning half of them (15). Washington won an impressive four outright basketball titles (in 1942, 1948, 1951 and 1952). The Presidents shared four titles: in 1943 (with Humboldt); in 1944 (with Murray); in 1949 (with Humboldt and Monroe); and in 1950 (with Monroe). Washington can boast of three scoring champions: Ed Patrow (1934); Tom Ahlgren (1962); and Pete Monson (1976).

The two teams played 53 games in head-to-head conference competition. To show how closely matched the two teams were, Murray won 27, Washington 26. The Pilots also outscored the Prexies 2,518 to 2,427 in those 53 games. The most exciting game had to be a double-overtime game on January 11, 1972 (in which Washington won 66-62).
