As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics in the St. Paul City Conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. One must always remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

Reflecting back on this past season, this year will be remembered as the year the streaks ended. Central ended its record conference winning streak at 45 games when Cretin defeated them. The Minutemen also suffered their first conference loss ever at home later on in the season against Harding. Johnson tied a conference record for consecutive losses with 30 (they tied the record set by the Governors in 1977 and 1978). Later this past season, Johnson won a home game (its first since 1976).

My heartiest congratulations to Coach Dan Brink and his Minutemen basketball team in capturing third place honors in this year's Minnesota State Boys' Basketball Tournament. Along with the Harding girls' basketball team copping second place laurels in the Girls' State Tournament, it once again points to the strength of the St. Paul City Conference in basketball.

As you peruse through the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams, and records of St. Paul City Conference basketball, 1971-1981. Happy reading!!
