*As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the St. Paul City Conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches need and deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. One must always remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.*

*This season Central tied a conference record by winning its fourth outright consecutive city championship (Mechanic Arts won the first four city titles in 1905, 1906, 1908, and 1909). Johnson recorded the most conference wins it has ever had (12). The Lee Carlson coached Govies posted as many wins this season as they have in the last seven. Quite a turn-around for a team that between 1977-1981 won a meager one game out of 61 conference games (twice tying conference records for consecutive losses at 30).*
