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FOREWORD



The 78th season of St. Paul City Conference Boys' Basketball is over. And for the thirteenth consecutive season I present to you my statistical report. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding. I hope you appreciate the time, effort and pride that I have placed in this and past statistical endeavors.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. My special thanks go to retiring Conference Athletic Director "Lefty" Gilleland for his help through the years and wish him well now that he can take it easy. Without the help of all that I have mentioned, this report could never have been produced.

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the St. Paul City Conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches need and deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. One must always remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

This season saw many highlights by both teams and individuals. Johnson won its first conference crown since 1941. The Govies posted their first undefeated conference season in fifty-one years. Other highlights for the Lee Carlson coached Govs saw them extend their conference winning streak to 22 games, a school record and third longest in City Conference history. They also scored the most points ever by a Johnson team in a conference game (93 against Humboldt). Peter Hanson of Cretin became only the eighth player in conference history to win two scoring titles and the sixth to win consecutive scoring honors (the last player to achieve this was Highland Park's Tom Morris in 1974 and 1975). Hanson joined Johnson's Scott Ackerson in entering the top ten all-time conference scorers. Hanson's 695 career points establishes him as the sixth all-time scorer; Ackerson is in tenth place with 600 points.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference basketball, 1982-1983. Happy reading!
