FOREWORD

The 79th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is over. And for the fourteenth consecutive year, I present to you my statistical report. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding. I hope you appreciate the time, effort and pride that I have placed in this and past statistical endeavors.



This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. Without the help of all that I have mentioned, this report could never have been produced.

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the St. Paul City Conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches need and deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. One must always remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

Central won its fifth title in six years and 22nd conference crown, tying Mechanic Arts for the most conference titles. The Dan Brink coached Minutemen won Region 3AA laurels and a very respectable third place finish in the State Tournament. For the first time in 46 years a player that had the best average in the conference did not win the scoring title. A mid-season injury forced Humboldt's Steve Aeilts out for the season; he played in less than two-thirds of his team's games (which is necessary to qualify for the title). This allowed Cretin's Steve Schneider to become the first sophomore to win the scoring crown since Central's Phil Rogers accomplished it in 1966. It was the third year in a row that a Raider won the scoring title. Only three other times in conference history has a school featured the individual scoring champion (it was last achieved in 1941-1943 by Mechanic Arts).

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember that players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball, 1983-1984. See ya.
