FOULS (MISCELLANEOUS)

There were 2,237 personal fouls called this season (compared to 2,208 personal fouls called last year -- a 1.3% increase in the amount of personal fouls assessed this season). There was an average of 31.1 personal fouls committed by both teams in each game (compared to 30.7 personal fouls per game last season). With the inception of the no foul-out rule, it is hard to estimate how many players would have fouled out since some players were left in without regard to fouling out. However, for comparison sake, I projected any player with five or more fouls as one that fouled out. 61 players fouled out (compared to 52 last season -- a 17.3% increase in the amount of players who potentially fouled out).
