## FOREWORD


*The 80th season of St. Paul City Conference Boys' Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This report is a look at the statistics of both this and past seasons. It is the 16th consecutive year that I have compiled a statistical report; the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding.*

*This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!*

*As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches need and deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.*

*This season saw many team and individual highlights. Central broke the record for consecutive wins in the conference. The Dan Brink coached Minutemen have now won 51 consecutive conference games (breaking the record they held previously at 45 games). The Minutemen then went on to capture Region 3AA honors and a very respectable third place finish in the state tournament. Humboldt stopped their conference losing streak at 52 games (prior to this streak, the record was set by two different Johnson teams with 30 losses). Cretin's Steve Schneider won his second scoring title and thus, became the third player in conference history to win scoring titles in their sophomore and senior years (the last player to achieve this distinction was Central's Phil Rogers in 1966 and 1968). Steve finished his conference career with 799 points (second on the all-time list).*
