FOREWORD

The 82nd season of St. Paul City Conference Boys' Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling stats for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

With less games played this season (due to Hill-Murray and St. Thomas no longer conference members), it is impossible to directly compare this season's stats with those of last year. I computed the average statistic from last season and pro-rated that number to create a total that could be used for comparison sake. Seasonal increases/decreases that have been affected are denoted with an asterisk ().*

This season Central established a record by winning its fifth consecutive conference title. Dan Brink and his Minutemen squad won their ninth title in ten years. The title was won on the final night of the season (when Central defeated Highland Park 75-56). Four teams had a chance to win or tie for the crown with only one week to play! Highland Park (105 points) and Harding (90 points) set team scoring records in games against Johnson. Jeff Thigpen set a Highland Park record by scoring 36 points in a conference game (breaking Tom Morris' mark of 35 points). The implementation of the three-point basket increased scoring by over 11%. For the first time ever in boys' City Conference play, there were three individuals that averaged over 20 points per game. All in all, it was a very exciting season of conference hoops.



As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference Boys' Basketball. See ya!

On Friday, April 15, Ron Causton announced his retirement as boys' basketball coach at Highland Park High School. Ron started coaching in the conference when he became head basketball coach at Murray High School in 1965-66. In his seven years at Murray, Ron compiled a 53-35 conference record, winning one conference title and sharing two others. He became head coach at Highland Park in 1972-73, amassing a 74-4 conference record in his first five years as the Scots head coach, winning the conference crown in four of those five years. His 16-year conference record at Highland was a very impressive 183-71. His 23-year overall record in the conference was 236 wins, 106 losses; winning or tying for the conference title seven times.

Coach Causton also produced many outstanding athletes at Murray and Highland Park. Names like Berry, Loeffler, Merrell, along with the brother combinations from the Johnson, Trammell and Healy families were all successful products of Ron's years of piloting the Murray Pilots. At Highland names like Morris, McLevish, Lauer, Keenan, Dayton, Rubin and Durand, just to name a few, are prominent on the Scots Who's Who list during the past 16 years.

Best of luck, Ron. You'll still get a copy of my annual stats report in the years to come so that you can keep up with your favorite conference -- the St. Paul City Conference.
