FOREWORD

The 83rd season of St. Paul City Conference Boy's Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding. My apologies for the lateness in getting you the report. It's been a very busy spring.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!


As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling stats for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his stats.

The 1980s can be best stated as the Central years. The Minutemen won a record sixth consecutive conference title this year (tenth in the last eleven years). During the '80s, the Dan Brink coached Central squads amassed an amazing conference record of 142-10 (93.4%)! Clearly no team has ever dominated a decade as Central just did. This season Central averaged a whopping 86.0 points a conference game (a record), twice breaking the century mark. After capturing conference honors, Central won Twin Cities Game and Region 3AA titles. They went on to finish fourth in the state.

Individual highlights were many this season. The Minutemen's Juriad Hughes tied a school conference record with 38 points against Cretin-Derham Hall while becoming the first Central player to win the conference scoring title since 1973. Cretin-Derham Hall's Jeff Rosga ended his conference career with 833 points, second only all-time to Highland Park's Tom Morris' 881 conference career points. Harding's Steve Olmstead's free throwing percentage was an amazing 88.9%, the highest in the nineteen years I've compiled the City Conference stats. All in all, it was a very exciting year in conference hoops.

This season also marked the 25th anniversary of a record that may never be broken in the conference. On February 4, 1964, Monroe's Hank Riehm scored 51 points in a game against Humboldt. The closest anyone has ever come to this record was in 1976 when Washington's Pete Monson scored 42 points.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference Boy's Basketball. See ya!
