## FOREWORD

*The 85th season of St. Paul City Conference Boy's Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 50 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding.*

*This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!*

*As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling stats for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.*

*Cretin-Derham Hall won its first outright City Conference championship this season. After breezing through the conference season without a loss, the Len Horyza coached Raiders claimed the Twin Cities title over Roosevelt. Cretin-Derham then went on to win the Region 3AA title, and culminated a 27-1 season by capturing the State Championship (defeating Roosevelt again, this time in an exciting overtime contest). Thus Cretin-Derham becomes the fifth conference team to win the State Boy's Tournament (the first since Humboldt won it in 1949). And with Harding's second place finish in the Girl's State Tournament, it's clear that this year's dominating conference in basketball was the St. Paul City Conference! Congratulations Coach Horyza and his talented Raider squad – you made us all proud.*



*Coach Gerry Keenan of Harding became the third coach in City Conference history to achieve 200 conference wins. Coach Keenan, in his 25th year of coaching, joins Ron Causton and Dan Brink in this elite club. Johnson's Jason Thompson won the scoring title, the first scoring title won by a Governor since Rick Tollefson won it in 1972. Jason's 21.1 scoring average was the highest ever achieved in the conference by a Johnson player. Runner-up in scoring was Harding's Jim Snidarich, who scored 35 points in a game against Como Park, just two points shy of the Knight single-game record held by Pat Bowlin (in 1978).*
