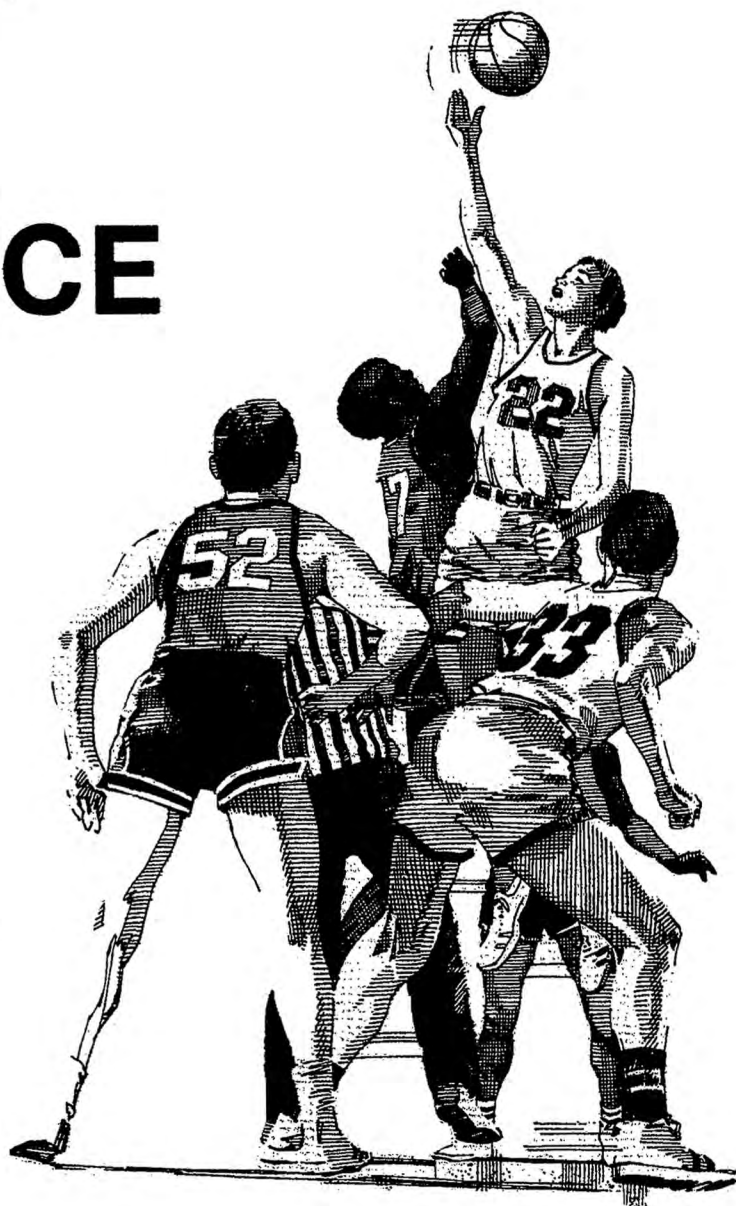

FOREWORD

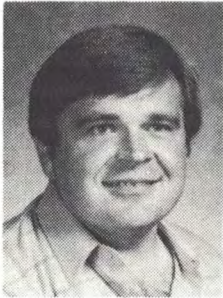
The 86th season of St. Paul City Conference Boy's Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplication and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling stats for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

For the 22nd time in Conference history, there was a tie for the City title. Central and Cretin-Derham Hall emerged as co-champions, splitting its conference games against each other. By defeating Cretin-Derham Hall, the Minutemen ended the Raider's conference winning streak at 24, their longest winning streak since joining the conference. The two teams met for a third time in the Section 3AA finals with the Raiders going on to the State Tournament. They defended their State Tournament Crown in fine fashion; ultimately losing to Anoka in the Championship game. Congratulations to Len Horyza and his talented Raider team. Central's Sly Johnson won the scoring title, the 16th time a Minuteman has led the City Conference in scoring.

This season, for the first time in 61 years, the conference did not play a balanced schedule by each school. As a stats person, true comparisons amongst individuals and teams is not fair unless an equal amount of games is played by every team. I have annually compared statistics from the just-completed season to the previous



season to see if scoring trends, etc., are evident. Since a different amount of games were played this season. I was forced to use a proportional number in lieu of the missing game to make fair comparisons. In cases where this was done, an asterisk () is noted. I would hope that this year was an exception and future years would return to a regular double round-robin schedule. If any school feels that the competition is not as good in the conference as they might get in a non-conference game, they should play an independent schedule. If any school feels that a team or teams are too strong as an opponent and would rather play an easier non-conference opponent (or no game at all), they, too, should play an independent schedule. Every team has the option of ten non-conference opponents; choosing the abilities of its opponent. But those 12 conference games are the one common link that all Conference schools share. **Let's keep it that way!!***

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference Boy's Basketball. See ya!
