FOREWORD

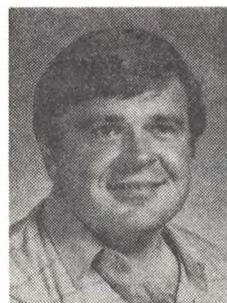
The 91st season of St. Paul City Conference boys basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 26th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

This season I have included in this report a new page which lists coaches all-time top ten in wins, winning percentage and years coached. It is located near the end of this report.

Last summer saw the passing of a coaching legend that we in the St. Paul City Conference were fortunate enough to witness for 18 years. I am, of course, speaking of Len Horyza. Coach Horyza was a class gentleman in the truest sense of the word.



His success as a coach has been well documented. What impressed me the most about Len was how he dealt with winning (and losing); perhaps something all coaches could hope to emulate. He will be missed.

Cretin-Derham Hall won a record tying seventh consecutive conference title (winning five outright and sharing the other two with Central). The Raiders now share the record also held by Central (1984-1990). Some of the other highlights of this season: Como Park's Demeris Allen won the scoring title, thus becoming the first Cougar to win the title since 1987 when Tony Smith won it.....Como Park scored 86 points in a game against Harding, the most points ever scored by the Cougars in a conference game.....Johnson scored a conference record 40 points in the second quarter in a game against Como Park.....Highland Park's Jawanza Curtis finished his career with the fifth best average ever at Highland Park (13.4).....Harding's coach Gerry Keenan notched his 300th career win.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys basketball. See ya.
