## FOREWORD


*The 92nd season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 27th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.*

*This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. This season I had everyone's sheets one week after the conclusion of the regular season. THANKS! You made this report possible!*

*As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.*

*This past season was the first season since 1966 that Gerry Keenan was not coaching varsity basketball in St. Paul. In his 30 years of coaching at both Mechanic Arts and Harding, Gerry epitomized the values and ideals of a high school coach. His genuine love for the game and the extra time he devoted to "his" game was well known, which was recognized when he entered the State Coaches Hall of Fame. All young coaches should hope they would share the same enthusiastic tendencies that Coach Keenan possessed. Thanks, Gerry for your tireless efforts and contributions to the St. Paul City Conference.*

*Highland Park won its first conference basketball title since 1977. In the process the Scots ended Cretin-Derham's record tying seven year reign as conference champs. Highland Park swept its two games with Cretin-Derham for the first time since 1982. Johnson ended a 24-game losing streak to the Raiders this season. Individually, the scoring race went down to the final game as Johnson's D'Marr Suggs edged out Como Park's Demeris Allen by five points. Suggs' 22.1 average is the highest ever by a Governor. His career conference total of 442 points ranks fifth on the all-time Johnson scoring list; his 16.4 career average is second only to Jason Thompson's 20.0 career avg. (1990-1991). Como Park's Allen scored a Cougar record 42 points in a game against Highland Park this season. His 469 career points ranks second on the all-time Como Park scoring list. Cretin-Derham's Dean Greenwood nailed a conference record seven three-pointers in a game against Harding.*
