FOREWORD


The 93rd season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 28th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. THANKS! You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

With the addition of Arlington to the conference, each team played two additional games which meant that comparing stats directly from last year to this year was not possible. Since I prefer to make comparisons from one season to the next, I took last year's numbers and multiplied that figure proportionally to acquire a total for comparison. Any increase or decrease using statistics that were adjusted are noted with an asterisk (*).

Central won its first outright conference title since 1989 (it shared titles with Cretin-Derham in 1990 and 1992). Cretin-Derham Hall lived for overtime, playing in three of the four o.t. games in the conference this season, then playing two in the sectionals. The Raiders' double-overtime win over Central was followed up by a heartbreaking o.t. loss to Mpls. North in the section finals. Arlington made an immediate impact in the conference, winning its first game ever played in the C.C. The Phoenix were a part of history



when they beat Humboldt 99-90, the most points ever scored by two teams in a game and also the most points ever scored by a losing team. Arlington's senior guard Nick Ambrasas set a single-game record of eight three-pointers in that same game against Humboldt. School conference records were also set this season when Harding scored 97 against Como Park and Humboldt logged those 90 points in that game with Arlington. Individual highlights: Central's Adam Hunkins moved into tenth place on the all-time Minutemen scoring list with 433 career points. Andy Carter's 38-point performance against Arlington tied a Central record for points in a conference game, sharing that honor with Stan Hill (1973) and Juriad Hughes (1988). Steve Priestley, Harding's

talented junior guard, won the conference scoring title with a 23.4 average, highest ever by a Knight and ninth highest ever by any player. His 328 points this season was the second-most ever by a Harding player (Pat Bowlin scored 403 in 1978 in an 18-game season). Those 328 points are the seventh highest one-season total ever. In becoming the first Harding male player to score more than 1,000 career points, he has amassed 688 career conference points, ninth on the all-time list. Steve should break Highland Park's Tom Morris' record of 881 points sometime next February.

Next year the conference will mark its 100th anniversary. I hope players and coaches alike will share in the celebration that is planned and encourage you to be an enthusiastic supporter.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball. See ya.
