FOREWORD

The 94th season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This was also a very special season in that it commemorated the centennial of the conference. My 29th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.


This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. THANKS! You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.

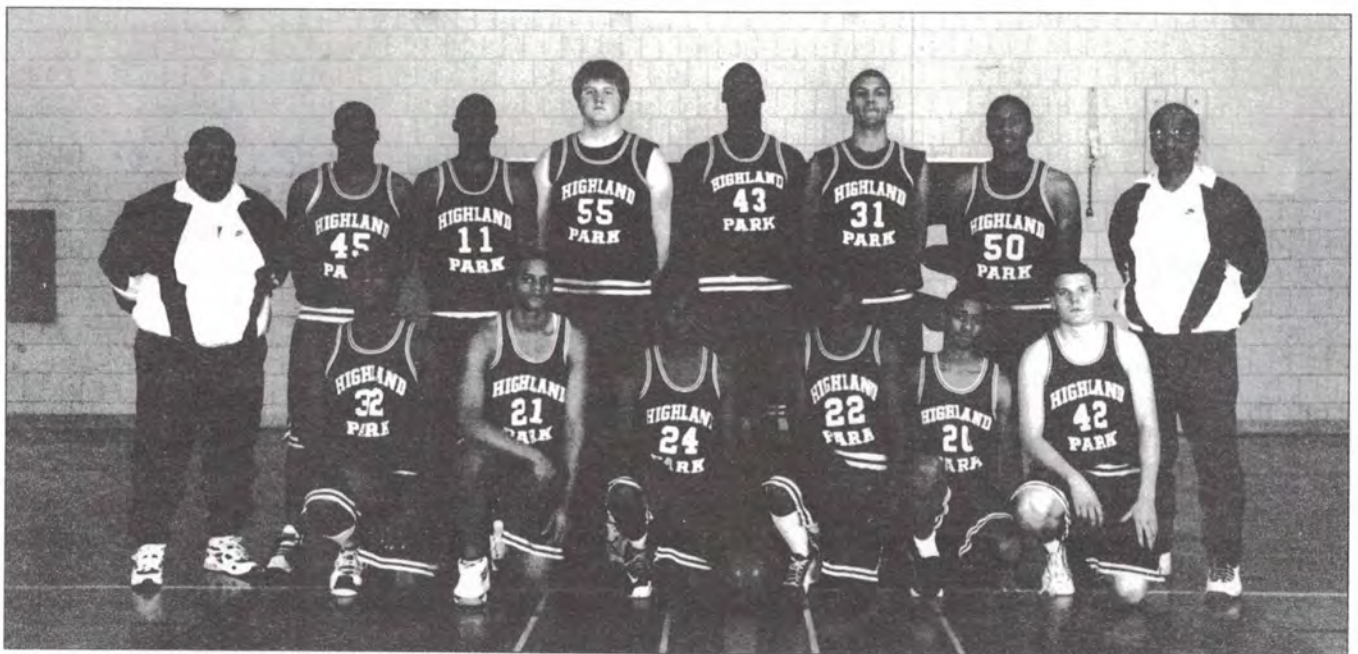
Highland Park won its second conference title in three years and eighth ever in the St. Paul City Conference. The Scotsmen would win the first Twin Cities Basketball Game for St. Paul since 1991 when they defeated Henry 76-75. The Charles Portis-coached Scots would capture the Section 3AAA title by defeating South St. Paul 61-43 and advance to the state tournament for the first time since 1977. Highland Park would "run the table" and win the Class AAA State Championship. It is the seventh time a St. Paul Conference school has won the state basketball title. Congratulations to Coach Chuck Portis and his talented Scotsmen. Harding's Steve Priestley became the all-time leading scorer in City Conference history when he hit a three-point basket late in the third quarter at Arlington on February 19. He surpassed the career mark of Highland Park's Tom Morris, who scored 881 career points in the conference from 1973-1975. Steve would end up with 923 points in conference games, 1,645 in all games (a Harding record). His 105 career conference three-point baskets is also a city record. Como Park's Reid Mahon won the scoring title, narrowly beating out Humboldt's Bob Green (the two were separated by three points). Sophomore Mahon is the second Cougar to win the scoring title this decade and the fourth player ever from Como Park. His 40-point game against Harding would have been a team record for six of the St. Paul schools but ranks only second ever at Como Park (Demeris Allen tallied 42 points against Highland Park in 1997). In that Harding game, Reid nailed five three-pointers in the fourth quarter, setting a conference record. When Humboldt beat Arlington 96-94 in overtime on the first night of conference play, it would be the most points ever scored in a conference game by Humboldt. The 190 points in the game also set a conference record (beating the 189 points these same two teams scored in a game last year). Harding also became the first boys team to ever convert over 70% of its free throws in the conference, making 70.6 from the charity stripe (the Knights Steve Priestley led the conference with a 78.2 percentage). In 1995 the Cretin-Derham Hall girl's team converted a record 71.1% of its free throws, the only other team to ever break the 70% barrier.



As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball. See ya.

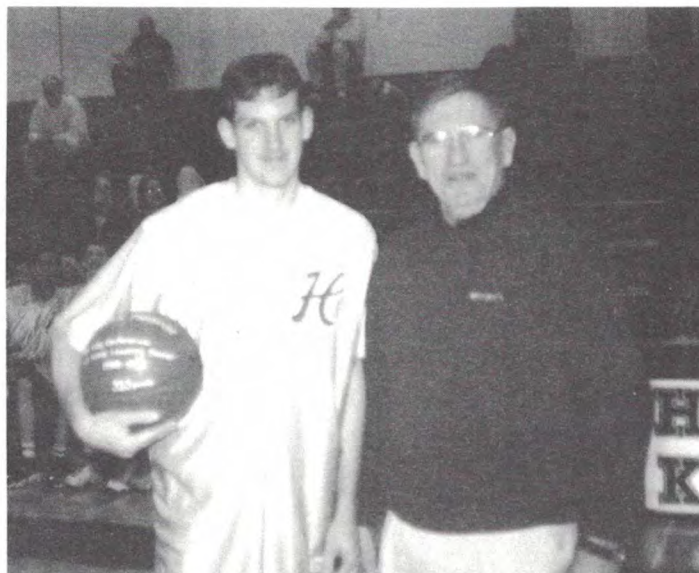

On January 9, 1996, Harding freshman guard Steve Priestley would come off the bench and score one point in his City Conference debut. It would be hard to imagine that 49 conference games later he would hit a three-point jump shot from the corner against Arlington and become the conference's all-time leading scorer. He would finish his conference career with 923 points, not only surpassing the previous boy's record of Highland Park's Tom Morris (881), he would outscore Harding's Shannon Loeblein girl's city mark of 900 conference points. Will someone ever break Steve's record? Probably...but it will take a four-year effort by someone who is dedicated to his team and the game of basketball as Steve was if the record is to fall. Congratulations to Steve Priestley, the all-time leading scorer in City Conference history.
