## FOREWORD

*The 95th season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 30th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.*

*This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach for submitting their home game statistics. THANKS! You made this report possible!*


*As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling these stats has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on his statistics.*

*Cretin-Derham Hall and Highland Park shared the conference title, the first time that has happened since 1992 when Central and Cretin-D.H. tied for the conference crown. It was the ninth title for Highland Park and the eighth by a Cretin-Derham team. The conference had four teams in three sectional finals, with Central, coached by Steve Lasley, emerging to the state tournament for the first time since 1989. Como Park ended the second longest conference losing streak at 47 when the Cougars beat Humboldt 67-66 in early February. The record is 52 by Humboldt from 1983-1986.*



*For the second year in a row the conference scoring title was decided by a narrow margin with Harding's Manuel Mitchell beating out defending scoring champ Reid Mahon of Como Park. Mitchell's 21.7 conference average this season is the third highest ever for a Knight and his career average of 18.2 in the conference ranks second in Harding history. He set a single game conference record for Harding when he tallied 41 against Humboldt, besting the previous mark of 37 by Pat Bowlin in 1978. Mahon, the talented junior Cougar guard, now has scored 554 points in his conference career and has become the all-time scoring leader at Como Park (he passed Donald West, 1984-1985, 530 points). Arlington's Terrance Dopson finished his conference career with 692 points in the conference, ranking tenth on the all-time scoring list. Cretin-Derham Hall's Joe Mauer posted a 20.4 conference scoring average this season, third highest ever for a Raider. His career conference average (15.7) places him fourth on the Cretin-Derham all-time list with one year of eligibility remaining. Humboldt's John Medellin set an unofficial conference record when he made 34 consecutive free throws during a span of eight conference games. He easily won the free throw shooting championship with an 86.2% conversion rate.*
