# FOREWORD

*The 96th season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 31st annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.*

*Cretin-Derham Hall rolled through the conference schedule without a loss and captured its ninth title. They became the first team since the Raiders of 1993 to win all of its conference games. The Raiders have now won 24 straight conference games, tying their school record for consecutive wins. They set a conference record by nailing an incredible 135 three-pointers this season, shattering the record of 82 held by the 1999 Humboldt squad. The Bill McKee-coached Raiders would lose their first game of the season on a last second lay-up against Henry in the Twin Cities Game. C-DH roared back to win the Section 2AAAA title and advance to the state tournament. They would lose to the eventual state champion Osseo in the semifinals but came back to capture third place honors with an exciting triple-overtime win over Tartan.*

*University of Minnesota-bound Mo Hargrow won the scoring title, becoming the first Highland Park player to lead the conference in scoring since Tom Morris won back-to-back titles in 1974 and 1975. He finished his career with 741 conference points, which ranks eighth on the all-time scoring list. Cretin-Derham's Joe Mauer capped off a fabulous three-year career (his and Mo's teams were 38-4 in the conference during that time) with 718 conference points, ranking ninth all-time. His career average of 17.1 ranks 16th on the all-time conference list. The final senior to distinguish himself on the all-time scoring list was Como Park's Reid Mahon. He would complete his four-year Cougar career as their all-time leading scorer with 748 conference points which puts him in seventh place all-time. Cretin-Derham Hall's Steve Sir made an impact on the conference in his only season of competition. His 61 three-pointers shattered the conference record of 46 held by Arlington's Nick Ambrasas. Twice he tied the single-game record of nine three-pointers. He tallied 41 points in a game against the Cougars, bettering the Raider conference record by four (37 points by Steve Schneider in 1984). His 309 points in the conference this season tied the single-season Raider record (Peter Hanson did it in 1982).*



*The final tidbit of information involves Humboldt. The Hawks broke the all-time record for team free throwing by converting 73.8% of their free throws, easily surpassing the record of 70.6% held by Harding in 1999.*

*Lastly, I would like to mention something that I have put a lot of time and effort in over the last six months -- the conference athletic Web site. I have painstakingly added many of the records and stats to the site, including the scores from all 3,751 basketball games played in the conference since 1905. ## SCORING (MISCELLANEOUS)

There were 7,326 points scored this season (compared to 7,108 points scored last season -- a 3.1% increase in the amount of points scored). The winning team average a record 75.1 points while the losing team averaged 55.8 points (this compares to last season's average of 72.2 points for the winner; 54.8 points for the loser).
