FOREWORD

The 97th season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 32nd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding. This is the first report ever generated totally from a computer and not replicated from my trusty old mimeograph machine. I trust you will enjoy the new look.

Cretin-Derham Hall won its tenth conference title, winning 13 of 14 games. The Raiders only loss of the season (to Central) ended their conference winning streak at a school record 35. This is the third longest streak in conference history, the record held by Central at 56 (1983-1987). The Mark Gautschi coached Raiders then went on to capture the Twin Cities Title, defeating Mpls. Henry 81-75. Three conference teams advanced to the finals of their sections, the first time that this has ever occurred. Unfortunately, all three (Cretin-Derham, Harding and Johnson) all were defeated and denied the chance to play in the State Tournament. It was the first time Harding had ever played in a section final and was Johnson's first chance since 1984. Harding would win 18 games during the season, a school record. Other team records set this year were points scored in a quarter by both teams (60, Johnson vs. Central) and three point field goals in a game by both teams (19, Cretin-Derham vs. Humboldt).



Cretin-Derham senior Mike Keating captured the conference scoring title, the eighth Raider to win scoring honors. The last Cretin-Derham player to win the title was Jeff Ellens in 1994. Mike would score 41 points in a game against Humboldt to tie the school conference record (Steve Sir tallied a similar amount last year against Como Park). Harding junior Jeff Reck set a conference and state record when he made an amazing 62 free throws in a row, all in conference games. He shattered the city mark of 34 by Humboldt's John Medellin, set in the year 2000. He broke the state record of 52 that was held by Rick Rickert of Duluth East, also in 2000. He would make 86 out of 90 attempts in conference play, a record 95.6%. He would help his Knight team set the team record in free throwing, making 74.9% of their free throws in the conference.

There was a noticeable increase in fouls called and the subsequent free throws awarded this season. There were 208 more fouls called (12.1% increase), 20 more players fouling out (an 80% increase), 205 more free throws made (+18.4%) and 363 more free throws attempted (which was 20.6% more than last year). I cannot explain the drastic increase in the assessment of fouls.
