# FOREWORD

*The 98th season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 33rd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.*

*The 2003 boy's basketball season in the St. Paul City Conference will go down as one of the more remarkable ones ever in conference history. If the slogan "on any given night" ever had any meaning, it was this year. After three conference games, each team had at least one win and/or one loss, the first time that has happened since the 1936-37 season. The conference co-champs Cretin-Derham Hall and Harding both suffered three losses in the conference, the first time since 1972 that a team would win the title with as many losses. To prove the parity in the league, even the last place team would win four conference games. That has only happened once, also in that 1936-37 season. The average margin of victory was 8.7 points, the lowest since 1952 when the margin was 8.2. Lastly, there were six overtime games, tying the all-time record originally set in 1945. It was one hell of a season!!*



*When Harding claimed a piece of the conference crown, the Knights ended a 43-year old drought on winning a boy's basketball title. They shared the title with Mechanic Arts in 1960. Previous to that year, their only other conference title was one they won outright in 1940. The Dean Keenan-coached Knights would win 20 games during the season, a school record. They would lose the Twin Cities Game to Mpls. Henry (who went on to capture the Class AAA State Title). For the second year in a row, the Knights would fall in the section final and be denied their first trip ever to the state tournament. Como Park, mentored by first-year coach but veteran to the conference Dan Brink, would also win a school record number of games (17). The Cougars would advance for the first time ever to the Class AAA State Tournament and did the conference proud by winning the Third Place Title.*

*Central senior Aramondo Davison captured the scoring title, the first Minuteman to do so since Sly Johnson turned the trick in 1992. He became only the sixth Central player to ever average more than 20 points a game in the conference. Como Park senior Jamil Lott would become the third highest conference point scorer in Cougar history. Lastly, Harding senior Jeff Reck would end his career in the conference with 803 points, ranking fourth on the all-time list. His 1,598 career points ranks second in Harding history behind Steve Priestley's 1,645. Last year, Jeff set the state record when he made 62 consecutive free throws, all in conference games. For his career, he would make 207 of 233 free throws in conference games, a mind-boggling 88.8%. Although there are no records throughout the annals of conference history that recorded free throwing, he certainly ranks as one of the best free throw shooters in conference history!*
