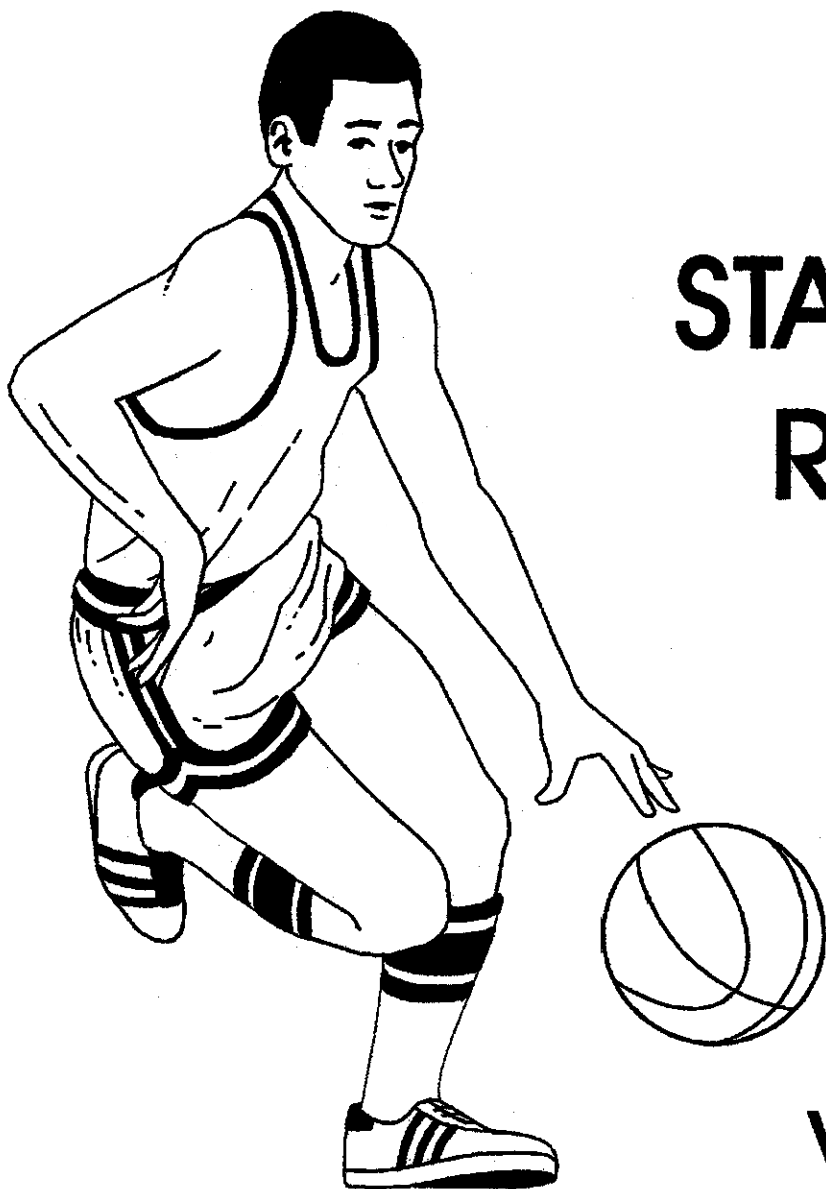

FOREWORD

The 99th season of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 34th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

It is traditional for me to compare, in this annual report, numerous statistics from one year to the next. With Cretin-Derham Hall no longer in the conference, each team played two less conference games. Because of this, it is impossible to directly compare this and last season. To get an idea of how the conference did in relationship to last season, I took a proportional amount per game and multiplied it to formulate a number that could be used to make comparisons. All numbers that have been treated in this fashion are noted with an asterisk ().*

For the second year in a row, two teams shared the conference championship. Highland Park claimed its tenth title while Johnson won its first title since 1983 and tenth overall crown. Prior to 1983, you'd have to go back to 1941 to find a Governor team that won a basketball title. For the third time in conference history, and the first time since the conference expanded from its original four teams, did a team go from finishing in last place one year to winning a title the following year. Johnson joins the 1913 Humboldt team and the 1920 Central squad as the only teams to every accomplish this fete. The Vern Simmons-coached Govies would lose a heart-breaker in the Twin Cities Game, falling to North by a 61-59 score. They would roll through the Section 4AAAA field and qualify for the State Tournament for the first time in 80 years. Johnson would finish in fourth place, garnering a school record 22 wins for the season. On an individual basis, junior Walter Haynes from Johnson won the scoring title, becoming the thirteenth Governor to win the scoring crown.



Next year is the 100th anniversary of the first basketball game ever played in the St. Paul City Conference. It was on Thursday, February 9, 1905, when Central defeated Mechanic Arts 21-18, that the conference would play the first of its 3,859 games in its illustrious history. I am hoping that a logo will be created and put in programs and posted in gyms, proudly displaying the fact that our conference is celebrating its centennial in basketball. With conferences realigning state-wide on a regular basis, it is reassuring to know that our conference has withstood the test of time and has remained strong and vibrant over the years.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site. The address is www.stpaulathletics.org and you will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boy's basketball. See ya.
