FOREWORD

The 100th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of the centennial of basketball in our conference. My 35th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



For the third year in a row (the first time that has ever happened), two teams tied for the conference championship. Central claimed its record 35th title while Johnson won back-to-back crowns for the first time since the 1926 and 1927 seasons. It was the eleventh title for the Governors. An anomaly occurred in the standings this year when four teams shared third place honors with losing 5-7 records. You'd have to go back to 1931, when there were only five teams in the conference, to find a third place team with a losing record. Johnson's Walter Haynes repeated as scoring champion, becoming only the second Governor to win consecutive scoring titles (Art Swenson was the first in 1928 and 1929). Walter also became the all-time Johnson leading scorer in conference games. His career 715 conference points easily surpassed Scott Ackerson's (1981-1983) point total of 600. Big Walter is now tied for eleventh on the all-time conference scoring list.

One thing that stood out while compiling this year's stats was the reduction of fouls called. This subsequently lowered the number of free throws made and attempted. This was true for both boys and girls basketball. In boys' hoops, they fell by 13.4%; for the girls', it was even greater at 15.1%. This equates to almost five fewer fouls in each game. I am at a loss to explain why there was such a sharp drop in fouls assessed. And why was it prevalent for both boys and girls?

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
