FOREWORD

The 101st season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 36th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



For only the second time in its history, Johnson won a conference basketball title for a third year in a row (they shared the title in 2004 with Highland Park and with Central in 2005) They had previously achieved this in 1922-1924. The Vern Simmons-coached Governors would capture Section 4AAAA honors and qualify for the state tournament. They would win their first game in the State and, ultimately, lose to eventual state champion Hopkins in the semifinals. The Govies finished with a 25-6 record for the year, the most wins ever by a Johnson basketball team. Central's Adam Kado would win the conference scoring title, narrowly beating out Johnson's Sammy Ricks by only two points!

This was the first season in which the state played two 18-minute halves rather than four eight-minute quarters. The additional playing time saw increases in several areas: scoring (an increase in points scored of 5.1%); free throws made (+17.1%), free throws attempted (+14.5%) and personal fouls (+12.1%). I think, on the whole, it was a better game with more time for more players to play. And there was more strategy involved with coaches utilizing their bench more than in the past.

My continuing research of the city conference is now focused on non-conference and post-season games. On the athletic Web site, I have included them in all seasons from 1970 to the present. My hope is, at this time next year, to have every score from every basketball game ever played by a city conference school. With it, school and coaching records could be embellished. Look for some of them next year in this report.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site (www.stpaulathletics.org). You will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
