FOREWORD

The 102nd season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 37th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



For the first time in its history, Johnson won a fourth consecutive boys' basketball title (they shared titles in 2004 and 2005 and won the last two outright). The Governors would win the conference with an unblemished record of 12-0, the first title winner to go undefeated since Cretin-Derham Hall did so in 1993. The Vern Simmons-coached Govies would defeat Mpls. Henry 79-77 to win their first Twin Cities Game title since 1923. For the sixth time in its annals, and the third in the last four years, Johnson would qualify for the state tournament when it won the Section 4AAAA title.

Although it would lose in the first round, the Governors tied a school record with 25 wins for the season (equaling the mark they established last year).

Central's Larry Brown won the scoring title with Greg Morse from Como Park a distant second. Larry joins fellow Minuteman and scoring champ from last year, Adam Kado, as the first back-to-back scoring leaders from the same school since Cretin's Peter Hanson and Steve Schneider performed that feat in 1983 and 1984. Arlington and Highland Park would set a conference record when they combined for 20 three-point field goals in one game (Arlington nailing 11 and Highland nine).

My research of the city conference continues to focus on non-conference and post-season games. On the athletic Web site, I have included them in all seasons from 1922 to the present. Next year at this time, I will have every non-conference and playoff score from every game every played by conference schools. I have included in this report (see last page) a listing of the all-time coaching records beginning in 1922 until the present time. This list will be complete as will a composite record of every team in next year's report.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site (www.stpaulathletics.org). You will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
