FOREWORD

The 103rd season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 38th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



For the twentieth time in conference history, there was a tie for the basketball championship. It's the fifth time in the last eight years that two teams have shared the title. Co-champ Johnson has now won or shared the title during the last five years (a school record). Central would represent St. Paul in the annual Twin Cities Game and, by defeating Henry 93-81, set a record for the most points ever in a T.C. Game by any school on either side of the river. It would mark the second straight win by St. Paul in this annual series, an accomplishment our schools have not achieved since Central turned the trick in 1988 and 1989. Johnson and Como Park would duel it out for the Section 4AAA crown with Como Park emerging the victor and qualifying for its second ever trip to the State Tournament. The Cougars would finish with 20 wins for the season, a school record.

Central senior Larry Brown narrowly won his second straight scoring title (beating out Highland Park's Prentice Cobbins by the difference of a made field goal). He becomes the eleventh player in conference history to win two scoring titles (no past Central player had ever accomplished this feat). Larry would complete his conference career with 582 points and an average of 17.1 ppg., garnering him a place on the top 25 list in conference history in both categories. Teammate Dylan Hale scored 39 points in a game against Arlington, setting the record for most points scored by a Central player in a conference game. It was the most points scored in a conference game since Cretin-Derham's Mike Keating tallied 41 against Humboldt in 2002. Freshman Estan Tyler from Johnson was the individual free throwing champion of the year, becoming the first Governor to claim that title since Monte DeBerry did it in 1984. Highland Park's Charles Portis won his 300th game as a St. Paul boys' coach this past season, joining an exclusive group of St. Paul mentors. He joins Gerry Keenan (302 wins), Ron Causton (311), Len Horyza (315) and Dan Brink (426).

My research of the St. Paul public schools non-conference and post-season games is, for the most part, complete. On the athletic Web site, I have every non-conference and playoff score from every game ever played by conference schools. I am also now able to list overall composite team and coaching statistics in both this report and on the Web site.

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site (www.stpaulathletics.org). You will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
