FOREWORD

The 104th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 39th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Johnson continued its dominance of the conference by winning or sharing in its sixth consecutive city title with an unblemished 12-0 mark. They would extend its school tying record to 22 consecutive conference wins (matching the school mark set in 1982-1983). The Vern Simmons-coached Governors would capture the Section 4AAA title and become the seventh Johnson team to advance to the state tournament. They would lose to ultimate state champ Minneapolis Washburn in the semifinals but then went on to capture third place honors. It was the highest finish ever for a Johnson team (having never won two games in past state tournaments). They would also attain school records in overall wins (27) and post-season wins (5). Congratulations to Coach Simmons and his talented Govie squad.

There were other team and individual highlights from this past conference season. Arlington would win nine conference games, tying a school record. The Phoenix would win 16 games overall, just one shy of the school record (17 in 2000). They would also lead the league in free throwing, the first time an Arlington team would accomplish such a feat. Highland Park would win three overtime conference games and become the first team to ever log three o.t. wins in a season. Only one other team has ever played in more overtime games in a season (Wilson played in four in 1943 but could only manage a 2-2 record).

On an individual basis, Arlington's Deandre White became the first Phoenix player to win the boys' scoring title. Humboldt's Josh Titus would lead the conference in free throw percentage, the first Hawk to accomplish this since John Medellin won it in 2000.
