## FOREWORD

*The 105th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 40th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.*



*What a year for the Johnson Governors!! They began by finishing undefeated in the conference, extending their conference winning streak to a school-record 34 games. They would defeat all non-conference foes, most notably Hopkins (Class AAAA State Champs), Henry Sibley (Class AAAA Third Place winners) and they would humble Mpls. North in the Twin Cities Game. They would cruise through the sectionals and advance to the state tournament with an undefeated record. It was the eighth time Johnson had qualified for the state. After lopsided wins over Hutchinson (80-37) and Winona (80-55), the state championship game proved the most exciting with the Govies prevailing over Grand Rapids 59-55. They would be the first St. Paul public school boys' team to finish the season undefeated and win the state crown. It proves when you gather a group of unselfish players with a basketball-savvy coach, greatness can be achieved. Congratulations to Coach Vern Simmons and his State Champion Governors!!*

*Throughout the season, Johnson would garner several conference records. They scored a record 75 points in one half against Como Park. The combined points in that half with the Cougars (117 points) was also a record. The Govies would lead the city in free throwing with the highest percentage ever achieved by a Johnson team (67.5% conversion). Central's LaDarian Horton won the scoring championship with an 18.8 ppg average. His Minuteman squad would make 15 three-point field goals in a game against Harding to set a conference record. In that game, the teams combined for 22 three-pointers, another conference record. Highland Park's Jimmy Sauser would make 50 threes in the conference season, the second highest single-season total (Steve Sir from Cretin-Derham holds the record of 61 in 2001). Bryale Winters from Humboldt would make a record ten three-pointers in a game against Arlington. Central and Harding finished the conference season in March by being a part of an unusual game in which no free throws were made. Central did not attempt any and Harding was 0-6 from the charity stripe. My records indicate that there were three times in conference history (1923, 1933 and 1939) where only one free throw was made by both schools but never had there been a game without any free throws made.*

*This season brings an end to the coaching career of Charles Portis, who saw 27 seasons in the City Conference at Como Park and Highland Park. His 1999 Highland Park team captured the State Class AAA Championship. He would coach in 643 games during those 27 years, winning 318 of them (194 in the conference). He was a fierce competitor but always was a gentleman, both on and off the court. Charles, you will be missed. Thank you for your years of service to our conference!!*
