FOREWORD

The 106th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 41st annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 50 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



It is traditional for me to compare, in this annual report, numerous statistics from one year to the next. With Arlington no longer in existence, each team played two less conference games this year. Because of this, it is impossible to directly compare this and last season. To get an idea of how the conference did in relationship to last season, I took a proportional amount per game and multiplied it to formulate a number that could be used to make comparisons. All numbers that used this formula are noted with an asterisk (*).

Johnson continued its mastery of City Conference boys' basketball this year by once again finishing with an unbeaten record. The Governors extended their school record conference winning streak to 44 games, edging closer to the boys' record of 56 games held by Central (1983-1987). Their overall record streak in all games ended in late December when they lost to Chicago Hyde Park at the Augsburg Tournament, ending a 39-game winning streak that began in March of 2009. The Vern Simmons coached Govies qualified for their third consecutive State Tournament (the sixth time in the past eight years).

Highland Park's Ty'shaun Williams won the scoring title in a close race with Central's Martin Smith (they were separated by only three points). Ty'shaun also won the free throwing title and became the first player since 1988 to achieve both crowns (Cretin-Derham Hall's Jeff Rosga was the last player to do so). Johnson's Estan Tyler ended his conference career in St. Paul by finishing with a 77.3% free throw conversion percentage, 13th best ever. During his four-year career, his Governor squads compiled an enviable 105-16 record!! Congratulations to Estan and all of this year's seniors.

This season brings a close to the coaching career of one of St. Paul's veteran hardwood coaches, Steve Elizondo. He coached varsity basketball for 21 years, 19 as the Hawks boys coach. Steve was another in a long line of former conference athletes that returned as a coach in St. Paul. As a player, Steve led his Humboldt team to its last boys' basketball title in 1978. He would mentor hundreds of West Side student-athletes and, although the odds of winning were sometimes against him, it never relinquished his enthusiasm for coaching and his love of the game. Steve, you will be greatly missed by Humboldt and our conference. Thanks for your years of service to St. Paul!!

My efforts in researching our conference's past has led to another new page in this report. I have created a list of the career top conference free throwers for your perusal. My researching also led to the discovery of a game on February 3, 1956, when Wilson and Mechanic Arts combined for 94 free throw attempts. It has been verified and is accepted as a state record!!

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference athletic Web site (www.stpaulathletics.org). You will not only find basketball stats but results and standings from all conference athletic events. In the next year, you will see drastic changes and improvements to the site..stay tuned!!

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the Web site, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
