

FOREWORD

The 107th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 42nd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

Johnson became the first boys' basketball team to log four straight undefeated conference seasons and again were the conference champs. The Governors are currently riding a 54-game conference winning streak, just two shy of the all-time boys' record of 56 held by Central in 1983-1987. Since 2004, the Governors have either won or shared the conference title every year. Johnson would lose a heartbreaker to Minneapolis Washburn 90-89 in the annual Twin Cities Game but rebound to roar through Section 4AAA and qualify for the state tournament for the fourth consecutive year (and seventh time in the past nine years). They would again lose to Washburn, the eventual State Class AAA runner-up but would bring home some hardware by winning the third place game over Grand Rapids 75-63.



One record that was broken was the average number of points scored by the winning teams in conference games (79.2). It surpassed the previous high of 78.3 in 2010. A total of 60 fouls were called in a game involving Highland Park and Johnson (each team had 30), which tied an all-time conference record held by Johnson and Harding in 2002. The Govs and Scots would attempt 85 free throws in that game, well short of the conference and state record of 94 set by Wilson and Mechanic Arts in 1956.

Johnson senior Marcus Marshall won the scoring title, averaging 20.4 points per game. He became only the fourth different Governor in the last forty years to win the scoring crown. He would also be the most prolific free thrower in the conference, making them at an 85.7% average, the highest percentage since Highland Park's Drew Dalton converted 88.2% in 2003. He would also lead the league in 3-point field goals with 22 and would amass a career total of 72, eighth best ever. It is no wonder that he would be voted the Most Valuable Player in the conference by the coaches. Ty'Shaun Williams would conclude his Highland Park career by making his free throws at 78.5%, the eighth best career percentage ever!!

Classy coach Vern Simmons from Johnson would surpass Cretin-Derham Hall's Bill McKee to now possess the best winning percentage in conference games with an amazing 81.5%. He would amass more than 250 overall wins in the shortest amount of time by any previous coach (Vern currently has 256 wins in his twelve years as the Governors mentor).
