

FOREWORD

The 108th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 43rd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

Before I go any further, you know that I annually like to compare the current year's statistics with those from last year. With the addition of Washington, the conference played 12 more games, making it impossible to directly compare the two seasons. So that some sort of comparison could be made, I added a proportional percentage to last year's statistics. Any comparison percentage that has been adjusted in such a fashion is noted with an asterisk (*).



Johnson would again win the conference title (the Govies have won or shared the title every year since 2004). They did, however, suffer their first conference loss since January of 2008. When Central defeated Johnson 53-49, the Minutemen stopped the Johnson streak at 55 consecutive conference games, just one shy of the all-time boys' record of 56 held by Central from 1983-1987. The Governors would go on and win the Twin Cities Game in record fashion, scoring an all-time best 99 points in their win over Southwest. They would roar through Section 4AAA and qualify for the state tournament for the fifth consecutive year (and eighth time in the past ten years). After defeating Delano 63-56 in the first round, they would lose to the ultimate state champion DeLaSalle. Congrats to Coach Vern Simmons and his very talented Governor squad -- Conference, Twin Cities, Section 4 and State AAA fourth place champions!!

Humboldt and Harding would tangle twice in the conference season with both games going overtime. This has happened only two other times in conference history and Harding was involved in both of them. Washington played two o.t. games with them in 1937 and, most recently, in 1988 when Highland Park did the same.

This season was more about individual scoring than any team records. Highland Park's Dion Bradley tallied 44 points in a game against Washington, the third highest points scored by an individual in a conference game. Two weeks later, Harding senior Ken Reed poured in 47 in a game against Humboldt. Kenny would finish the season averaging 23.8 points per game, normally enough to win the scoring title. But it was only good enough for second place. Dion shattered the single season average record by scoring 28.3 ppg, easily beating the previous best of 26.9 by Hank Riehm of Monroe in 1964. Bradley would conclude his four-year career in the conference (never missing a conference game) by scoring 773 points, sixth highest ever. His 17.6 career average in those 44 conference games puts him 17th on the all-time average list. One final note on Ken Reed, his three-year career average in the conference was 19.0, seventh highest ever. Quashingm Smith-Pugh, while wearing the Johnson jersey for the past three years, saw his Governor teams post an enviable 69-22 overall record. No doubt his leadership led to many of those Johnson conquests. To these seniors, as well as all of the other seniors in the conference, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
