

FOREWORD

The 109th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 44th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

It would be impossible to begin this report without mentioning the weather we all had to endure this past winter. The snow and cold led to eleven conference games being rescheduled and several other non-conference games that were either postponed or cancelled. It should make us all appreciate any winter that is "normal."



Johnson would once again win the conference crown with an unblemished 12-0 record (every year since 2004 the Govies have either won or shared the title). They have also started another winning streak in the conference (now at 22). Johnson's average points scored in conference games was 92.0, shattering their 2010 record of 87.0. The Governors would lay claim to the Twin Cities Game title by outlasting a young Minneapolis North team by the score of 91-81. A scrappy Central squad would await Johnson in the Section 4AAA title game and emerge victorious by a 60-56 score. The Minutemen qualified for the State Tournament for the first time since 2000. They then had the unenviable task of playing first round foe DeLaSalle (who ultimately won the Class AAA title). Kudos to coaches Vern Simmons and Scott Howell for showcasing our conference's boys' basketball talent.

Looking back at this past season, there are numerous scoring items to mention. A record six times teams would score 100 points or more (the previous best was three in 1988, 2001, 2010 and last year). In a

Como Park 111-104 win over Humboldt, both teams would crack the century mark. They would set school single game scoring records as well as most points scored by both teams in a game (215) and points scored by the losing team (104). In that game, the two teams would combine for 21 three-point field goals (14 by Humboldt), one short of tying the all-time record of 22 which occurred in a Central vs. Harding game in 2010. Humboldt's total of 14 was also one short of the record held jointly by Cretin-Derham Hall (in 2001) and Central (in 2010).

As far as individual honors, Humboldt's Demond Dawson would win the scoring title, besting Como Park's Demetrice Mitchell by a scant seven points. He would become the first Hawk scoring champion since 1995 when Dridge Johnson bested the conference in scoring. He is the thirteenth Humboldt player to win a scoring title but only the third since Jim Fritche's state championship senior year in 1949. Washington's Da'veonte Adams would post the best free-throwing conversion rate at 86.5%. This is the highest percentage since 2003 when Highland Park's Drew Dalton made 88.2% of his free throws. Da'veonte would be aided by a streak of 28 consecutive free throws made in conference games. It's amazing that this total is dwarfed by the all-time record of 62 set by Harding's Jeff Reck in 2002 (this still stands as the second longest streak in state history!!) To our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
