

FOREWORD

The 110th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 45th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Johnson would once again win the city title (for 12 consecutive seasons, they have either won or shared the city crown). They extended their consecutive win streak in the conference to 34 games after finishing 12-0 this year. The Governors would face Mpls. North in the annual Twin Cities Game and when the dust had settled after two overtimes, emerged victorious with a 123-119 win!! The teams set the state record for the most points scored by two teams in a game (242) and North established the state record for the most points scored by a losing team. The Govs would roll through Section 4AAA and qualify for the State Tournament for the twelfth time in school history. After knocking off Hermantown and Waconia, they faced, in the championship game, the three-time defending Class AAA champion DeLaSalle. Unfortunately, the shots did not fall in that game for Johnson but they certainly can boast of a successful year as the state runner-up. Congratulations to Vern Simmons and his talented Johnson squad!

Harding and Humboldt would set a conference record for three-point field goals made in a game when the two teams combined for 23 (the previous record was 22 in a 2010 Harding vs. Central game). By nailing 14 three-pointers in that Humboldt game, the Knights fell one short of the conference record held jointly by Cretin-Derham Hall (2001) and Central (in 2010).

As far as individual honors, there was a first ever in the conference. Two individuals finished first and second in scoring for two consecutive years. Humboldt's Demond Dawson won the scoring title again this year with Demetrice Mitchell of Como Park finishing second. Demond would become only the second Humboldt player to ever win back-to-back scoring titles (the legendary Jim Fritsche was scoring champion in 1948 and 1949). His conference average this year was 21.8, placing him #20 on the all-time highest averages for one season. He would finish his conference career with a 17.1 average, also good for #20 on the all-time list. Demetrice did best in that category. He finished his career at Como Park with a conference average of 18.3, ranking eleventh on the all-time scoring average list. Harding junior Essa Adam tied the conference record for most three-point fields goals in a game with ten (tying Humboldt's Bryale Winters mark set in 2010). Finally, I would be remiss by not mentioning another fine senior who ended his career this season. Johnson's Jalen Mobley was recognized the past two years as the MVP of the conference. He set the Governor school record in scoring 52 points in that previously mentioned Mpls. North game and is also the all-time scoring leader at Johnson with 1,483 points. His unselfish attitude as the Governor playmaker will be missed next year. To our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
