FOREWORD

The 111th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 46th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central and Johnson tied for the conference title, the 19th time in conference history that teams shared the city crown. Johnson has now won or shared the title for a record 13 consecutive years!! They did, however, end its conference winning streak at 36 (the fourth longest streak in conference history) when Highland Park defeated the Govies (the first win for the Scots over Johnson since 2006). Washington defeated Highland Park for the first time ever in the conference, ending a 32-game streak that first began in 1965. For the first time since 2005, no conference team qualified for the state tournament (matter of fact, since 1999, it has happened only twice).

The conference did see a dramatic increase in scoring as both teams would average in conference games 141.2 points, shattering the previous high of 134.6 in 2014. The losing teams averaged 64.2 points, breaking the conference record previously achieved in 2006 of 59.4 points per game. Como Park and Humboldt played a three-overtime game thriller that tied the conference record for most overtime sessions (it has happened only one other time—on March 3, 1933 when Washington beat Central 20-18). The third overtime stanza in that game was sudden-death. The conference saw an improvement in free throwing when the average conversion percentage jumped from 57.7% to 59.3%. That is still well off the all-time record that was set by our teams in 1997 at 64.3%. Harding converted free throws at a conference best 69.4% clip this season, the ninth best ever for a conference team in a single season. Curiously, last season, the Knights finished dead last in free throwing when they made a dismal 46.2% of their free throws.

Como Park senior Demetrice Mitchell, runner-up in the individual scoring race the past two seasons emerged as the scoring champion with a fine 25.8 ppg average (the third best ever in the conference). He is the fifth Como Park player to win the scoring title. He would finish his conference career with 749 points, tied for eighth best ever and nipped Reid Mahon (1998-2001) by one point as the all-time best Cougar scorer. His career conference scoring average was 20.8 ppg, the fourth best average ever in our conference. Harding's Essa Adam finished his conference career with the third highest free throw conversion rate of 82.8%. He also had 71 three-point field goals in his conference career, ninth best ever. Washington junior James Boua-Taylor nailed 42 three-pointers this conference season, the fifth highest total for one season. Washington's Xavier Storay set the dubious record of fouling out nine times this season, tying the record for the number of times fouling out in conference games in one season with Pete Monson, also from Washington, in 1975. However, Pete played 16 conference games in 1975. Xavier's average fouls per game of 4.58 also set a conference record. To all of our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
