FOREWORD

The 112th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 47th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



For the first time since 2003, Johnson did not win or share the conference title, ending a record 13-year reign for Vern Simmons' Govies. Central would capture the city title, losing only once (to Highland Park). It's the Minutemen's first solo crown since 1998. There were numerous close contests, including four that went overtime. The average differential from the winning and losing team's score was only 9.5 points, the lowest since the 8.7 in 2003. And speaking of those overtime games, Johnson was involved in three of them and they were played consecutively. That's the first time in conference history that a team played three conference overtime games in a row. Humboldt ended a 25-game conference losing streak when the Hawks nipped Harding 63-61 in January. Highland Park won 23 games overall, the second most wins in a season for the Scots. Only in their state championship season in 1999 did they win more games (27).

Unfortunately for the conference, for the second year in a row, no conference team qualified for the state tournament. Lastly, Humboldt won the city title at the ninth grade level, the first time that has ever happened!!

On an individual basis, Washington's senior Curtis Bell won the scoring title, the first Washington player to win the title since Pete Monson accomplished this in 1976. Matter of fact, Curtis is only the fourth Washington player to do it. He blistered the conference at a torrid pace of 27.5 points per game. This ranks second only to Highland Park's Dion Bradley and his 28.3 average during the 2013 season. Curtis amassed 843 points during his four-year conference career, ranking as the third most points scored in conference games. Curtis would also set a conference game record for Washington when he tallied 43 points in a game against Central. It broke the record set by the aforementioned Pete Monson in 1976 of 42 points.

Harding's sophomore whiz Jovan Christian captured the free throwing championship again this year. He is the first player to win back-to-back free throw titles since Jeff Reck, also from Harding, did it in 2001 and 2002. Seniors Amitri Collins-Westlund from Highland Park and James Boua-Taylor from Washington both climbed into the top ten list of converting three-point field goals for their teams in conference games. Collins-Westlund moved into fourth place, all-time, with 77 threes and Boua-Taylor's total of 75 ranks ninth. To all of our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
