FOREWORD

The 113th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 48th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



After missing out on the title last year, Johnson regained the championship throne this year. The Vern Simmons-coached Governors have won or shared the title 14 of the past 15 seasons!! This year their undefeated season included a 101-90 thriller over perennial rival Central. It was the first time a Central team had allowed triple digits in a conference game. Speaking of Central, this year they averaged an eye-popping 92.9 points in conference games, surpassing the conference record previously held by Johnson of 92.0 in 2014. Over all, scoring in the conference was up by over 5% this year. The winning teams averaged 83.2 points a game, eclipsing the previous best average of 79.2 in 2012.

For the first time since 1931, there were conference games forfeited due to the use of ineligible players. Three conference games and two non-conference games were affected by forfeits. Let's hope it's another 87 years until the next forfeits!! And just so you know, all of the statistics in those forfeited games count.

On an individual basis, Central junior Daveonte Davis won the scoring title with a fine 24.7 ppg average. Matter of fact, the top five scorers in the conference are all underclassmen. Harding junior Jovan Christian led the conference in making three-point field goals and his conference career total of 85 ranks fourth best all-time. With any luck next year, he should be able to break the record of 105 set by Harding's Steve Priestley during the 1996-1999 seasons. The honor of the best free thrower in the conference belongs to Washington sophomore Drewjuan White when he made 90.0% of his conference free throws. It was only the third time in conference history that a player shot at a 90% or better percentage. Johnson's Kyle Lee finished his conference career as a Governor by making 75.9% of his free throws, good for 22nd best all-time. To all of our outgoing seniors, thanks for the memories and best of luck!!
