FOREWORD

The 114th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 49th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.

The conference recently lost two icons that previously coached in our league as well as one of them led his high school team to its only state championship. Legendary football coach Ken Mauer mentored both Humboldt and Harding football squads for a total of 35 years and 165 conference wins, both are records that will never be equaled. Jim Fritsche led Humboldt to the state championship in 1949, earning All-State honors as a center. He would return to the conference as Central's baseball coach for 23 years and was the head basketball coach for nine years. This stats book is dedicated in their memory.



Central won the city championship, posting a perfect 12-0 record (the first time Central went undefeated in the conference since 1989). Overall, they would win 22 games, the most since a 23-win season, also in 1989. The Scott Howell coached Minutemen easily defeated all conference foes, averaging a margin of victory of 33.5 points. It was the other six schools that had to fight for every conference win – you weren't surprised if any of these teams would defeat another conference team. Three teams scored school-high record point totals: Central (110) against Washington; Harding over Simley (102) and Humboldt scored a school-record 108 against Kaleidoscope Charter. Central would also win the Twin Cities Title with a 77-74 win over Mpls. North. No St. Paul team advanced past the section semifinals. Other noteworthy highlights: Humboldt beat Johnson for the first time since 2003; Highland Park would average 23.1 fouls per game, the second highest average ever; Washington made 15 three-pointers against Humboldt, tying the city record.

On an individual basis, Harding senior Jovan (Jo Jo) Christian ended his four-year career at Harding with 815 conference points, fifth most ever in city history. His overall career total of 1,615 points tied the Knight's Steve Priestley for the most points scored by a male Harding hoopster. He also finished with a conference best 115 career three-pointers. Central senior Daveonte Davis, last season's scoring champ, would have to settle for second this year with his 20.1 average. His three-year conference career total of 721 points stands as 14th best and his average of 21.9 as the fourth best all-time. Washington junior Zaveon Smith won the scoring title with a fine 23.8 points per game average. Como Park's Donzello Barros made his free throws at an 83.0% clip, best in the conference. Lastly Harding senior Tierre Davis tallied a conference-high 42 points in a game against Washington (31 of those in the first half).
