## FOREWORD

*The 115th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My 50th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It normally takes around 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding to complete these reports.*



*It was with a heavy heart that I finished the work on this year's report. Who would have ever thought that, during our lifetime, a world-wide pandemic would hold us hostage from doing even the simplest of things? The severity of COVID-19 impacts all of us. Please stay safe during these troubling times...hopefully, we will prevail!!*

*For the first time ever, I will not be printing multiple copies of this report. Because of the school closures, I no longer had a source of duplicating the report. There is also the issue of how to distribute hard copies with buildings being shuttered. I hope that everyone understands and realizes that it is only for one year. Last spring, I was able to scan all of the previous reports and they are available for viewing (and printing). Visit the archives on our website and go to the boys' basketball section. A copy of this year's report will also be available.*

*Central and Johnson would tie for the city title this year, the fourth time those two teams tied for the top spot in the past 16 seasons. Regrettably, no team advanced to their section semifinals, the first time that has occurred since sectional play began in 1976. Another casualty of the virus was the cancellation of the state tournaments for both boys' and girls' basketball. One team highlight this season was Harding and Washington both scoring a school record number of points (in the same game). In a non-conference holiday tournament contest, the Knights won 109-106. Washington would gain revenge by beating Harding both times in conference play.*

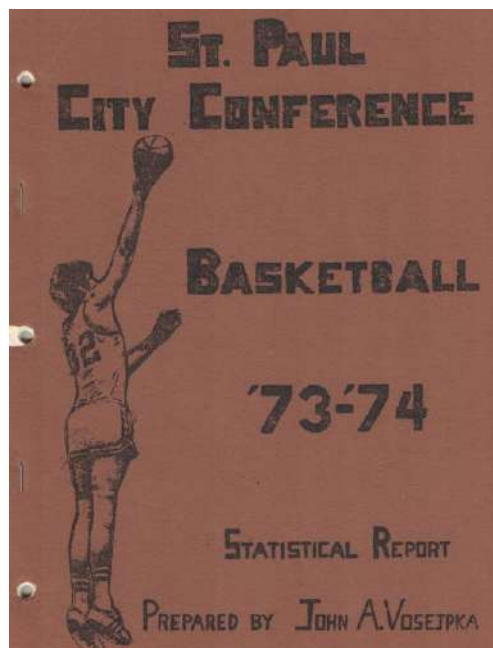
*As far as individual highlights, two Washington seniors stole the limelight. Drewjuan White won the scoring title with an average of 23.0 points a game. His teammate Zaveon Smith (last year's scoring champ) capped his career with the highest conference average for a Washington player with 21.7 ppg. This ranks fourth highest in conference history. His total points of 761 ties him for ninth place on that scoring list. Drewjuan finished his four-year career with 742 points (14th on that all-time scoring list). Harding senior Simeon Sharp set a city record by a conference player when he tallied 58 points in that 109-106 win over Washington. He was only the fifth conference player to ever score 50 or more points in a game. Simeon's 58 points was the second highest point total for any player in the state this season. The most was by Asher Zubich from Mountain Iron-Buhl – 61 points against Mesabi East on January 30. On January 14, Johnson coach Vern Simmons recorded his 400th career win, becoming only the second coach to reach that mark! His current total of 410 wins ranks second only to Dan Brink's career mark of 426 victories.*

## HOW IT ALL BEGAN.....

*I compiled my first statistical report for the conference during the 1970-1971 season. For the first three years, they were simple scoring stats that I obtained from newspaper box scores and were sent to the coaches at the conclusion of the season. It wasn't until the 1973-1974 season that I wanted to expand the statistics I published. To do this, I requested coaches send me a completed form for each of their conference home games. The first report contained 39 pages. As the years passed, I included more and more information as well as doing additional archival research that continued to embellish each annual report. The first 28 versions of the reports were typed and duplicated "old school" by using an antiquated mimeograph machine I had acquired from Mechanic Arts High School after it closed in 1976. An IBM Selectric typewriter was used to create the mimeograph stencils. It wasn't until 2002 that I started using a word processor which afforded me the chance to duplicate reports using a high-speed copier. I would estimate that I spent around 3,000+ hours in processing past reports as well as researching the history of boy's basketball in our conference.*
