FOREWORD

The 116th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This 51st annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



The pandemic continued across the world and it affected our basketball season, as well. The regular season started on January 15 this year, almost eight weeks later than normal and nearly two weeks later than most teams in the state. Although 18 regular season games were played by most statewide, St. Paul restricted the number to conference games only (and fans were not allowed to attend). The six non-conference games lost represented a third of a season in games that weren't played. For the first time since 1971, no Twin Cities Boys' Basketball Game was played. Central and Humboldt would advance to the semifinals in their sections. Fortunately, compared to many fall sports, there was a completed post-season of competition. Let's hope next year our basketball season (and our country) returns to some semblance of normalcy. In the meantime, stay safe!!

For the first time since the 1999-2000 season, a familiar face was missing from the coaching sidelines. When he first took over coaching at Johnson, Vern Simmons inherited a program that had seen so many years of instability. In a four-year stretch in the 1990's, Johnson had four different boys' coaches. After one year, the program took off and, from 2004-2015, the Governors won at least 21 games each year. The pinnacle was reached in 2010 when his Govies posted a perfect 32-0 record and won the State Class AAA Title. His 410 career wins ranks second in conference history. Congratulations to Vern and his year's of success at Johnson and I hope he enjoys his retirement!!

The conference championship would be determined on the final day of the regular season when Highland Park traveled to Central, hoping for a win to share the title with the Minutemen. The two teams would need more than regulation time to decide the game (the first time the two teams had ever played a conference regular season overtime game). The game would be decided in the second overtime when, with 43 seconds remaining and a 49-49 score. Highland Park freshman Andrew Bacigalupi, playing in only his second varsity game, nailed a three-pointer to put the Scots ahead for good as they would win 56-53. It was the second season in a row where two teams shared the title (and the third in the past six seasons). Highland Park had not won a city title since they shared it with Johnson in 2004. One team highlight was when Highland Park and Humboldt combined for a conference record 27 three-point field goals (Highland Park with 16). Individually, Como Park junior Donavan Clinton won the scoring title with a fine 21.7 PPG average.

There was a drastic reduction in many statistics this year, noticeably in scoring (9.7%), free throws made (26.5%), attempts (24.0%) and in the number of fouls called (17.7%). Free throws were made at an alarmingly low 55.9% (the lowest since 1986 when it was 54.9%). Our conference girls also saw their numbers tumble. You will have to surmise for yourself why this occurred (the wearing of masks?—less fouls called by the officials?)

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball stats but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
