FOREWORD

The 117th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This 52nd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



The affects of the pandemic were still felt in the conference. Although a full non-conference schedule was played this year, ask Humboldt how COVID altered their schedule? In a two week span in January, the Hawks were quarantined without being able to play a game or practice. Then they had to squeeze 14 games into a five week period (ten of those were conference games). Let's hope the COVID-19 days are behind us and we can look forward to next year without any delays.

After a one-year absence, Johnson returned to the conference championship circle in winning this year's title with an unblemished 12-0 conference record. The Govies did battle Como Park for the title, winning both games (52-49 at Johnson) and a classic that was played at Como Park (a 65-63 nail-biter that saw Como miss a three-pointer at the buzzer). The Colin Moore-coached Governors played Mpls. North (the eventual Class AA runner-up winner) in the Twin Cities Game, falling to the Polars 59-56. Speaking of Como Park, the Cougars, winless just two years ago, rose to claim second place in the conference and posted a fine 16-10 overall mark (the most wins for Como Park since 2008 when they had 20). Highland Park scored a school record 110 points against Washington. The two teams combined for 193 points in that game, the third highest total points scored by two teams in a game (well short of the record 215 held by Como Park and Humboldt in 2014). Washington ended a 22-game losing streak in the conference.

On an individual basis, Como Park's Donavan Clinton won the scoring title again. In doing so, he became the 13th boys basketball player to win more than one scoring crown (and the first time for Como Park). He finished his three year career at Como Park with a sparkling 21.1 average in conference games (good for fifth best all-time). His 22.9 average this year ranks 19th on the all-time list.

This year it took longer than normal to get everyone's copies from their score books. There were two cases where certain score books couldn't be located. I urge all of you to keep one score book for your home games only. I also encourage you to use the Star Tribune's basketball hub to enter both your scores and individual points scored in each of your games. It seems like every year I will get an email from a coach, parent or athletic director wondering how many career points a player has scored. This is especially true for those that may have scored 1,000 career points. Unfortunately, I can only give the number of conference points scored. Do your players a favor by using the Star Tribune hub!!

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball info but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. The archives section contains so much information!! Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
