FOREWORD

The 118th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This 53rd annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



For the second year in a row, Johnson claimed the conference title. The title was not determined until the final week of the season when Highland Park and Central both had chances to share in the title. The Colin Moore-coached Governors would qualify to play in the Annual Twin Cities Game, only to fall to Mpls. North 86-72. They would be the only conference team to make it to the Sectional semifinals. Humboldt ended a 22-game losing streak in the conference.

Looking at individual statistics, Como Park claimed another scoring champion when junior Mason Aarness captured the title, becoming the third consecutive winner from Como Park (Donavan Clinton won the title in 2021 and 2022). Johnson's DeWayne Givens returned to the conference after a three-year absence (attending Minnehaha Academy, Mpls. South and Hopkins) to be named Player of the Year! An interesting stat was discovered when compiling this year's free throwing information. Highland Park sophomore Yared Yohannes made 27 out of 29 attempted free throws to win this year's free throwing title. His 93.1% conversion rate in the conference is the third best ever! Those with better percentages were Central's Bernard Bilski in 1929 (he made 18 out of 19 attempts for a 94.7% conversion percentage) and the all-time leader is Harding's Jeff Reck who made 86 out of 90 in 2002 for a staggering 95.6%. That was the season that Jeff made 62 consecutive free throws in the conference, at the time a state record (now it is the second most ever; LeSueur-Henderson's Tyler Schmidt made 72 in a row during the 2008 season).

I am pleased to report that I received everyone's copies from their score books within a week of the season ending!! This explains why you are receiving your copy of the stats book a full two weeks earlier than last year.

*This season I received two requests for career points scored for players. I assume they were approaching 1,000 career points. In both cases, I had to report back to the coach that my stats are only for conference games. It is the responsibility of each team to keep track of that scoring information. I have found the best way is to use the Star Tribune's basketball hub. By updating your individual scoring after each game, you keep a permanent record of individual scoring. Their records go back as far as the 2010-2011 season. However, they are only as good as the coach or scorer that uses it for **all** of the games. If I haven't convinced you to use it this year, please consider it for next year!!*

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball info but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. The archives section contains so much information!! Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
