FOREWORD

The 119th season of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball is now history. You were part of that history. This 54th annual report is a look at some of the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It represents more than 40 hours of compilation, typing, duplicating and binding.



Central won the conference title outright for the first time since 1998 (they had shared it five times since then). The Scott Howell-coached Minutemen finished without a conference loss (they hadn't done that since 1989). They lost the Twin Cities Game to Washburn but were one of four city teams to win at least one playoff game.

This was the first year of the 35-second shot clock and here is how it affected the stats: scoring increased 7.3%; 3-pt field goals were up 23.1%; free throws made +9.7% and free throws attempted increased by 5.0%. I am convinced that the shot clock is here to stay!

Looking at individual statistics, Washington junior Shawn Huberty stormed through the conference season, averaging a blistering 27.6 PPG (this is the second highest ever for one season – only Highland Park's Dion Bradley's 28.3 in 2013 is greater). Shawn set a conference school record with a 44-point game against Highland Park. The previous Eagle record was 43 by Curtis Bell in 2017. Highland Park made free throws at a staggering 72.8% (fourth best ever!). Scot junior Yared Yohannes has now made free throws at an amazing 83.9%, second only to Harding's Jeff Reck (who finished his career with an 88.8% conversion rate). But Yared was unseated this year as the free throwing champ by Johnson's Jalani May, who made 35 of 42 for an 83.3% rate.

This season saw five male basketball players in the conference reach the 1,000 point pinnacle. It is rare to have one, much less five achieve this mark in the same season. Senior's Xavier May from Highland Park, Como's Mason Aarness and Albert Wellington from Humboldt are now on the list. Juniors Allan Lankford, Jr. from Central and Harding's Ai'Jhon Douglas have another year to add to their career totals. I have decided to print the all-time 1,000+ club members on the next page. It is compiled by The Minnesota Basketball News.

Once again this season I received two requests for career points scored for players. In both cases, I had to report back to the coach that my stats are only for conference games. It is the responsibility of each team to keep track of that scoring information. I have found the best way is to use the Star Tribune's basketball hub. By updating your individual scoring after each game, you keep a permanent record of individual scoring. Their records go back as far as the 2010-2011 season. However, they are only as good as the coach or scorer that uses it for all of the games. If I haven't convinced you to use it this year, please consider it for next year!!

Don't forget that complete statistics, including this year's All-Conference team, are found on the St. Paul City Conference volunteer community-based athletic website (saintpaulsports.org). You will not only find basketball info but schedules, results and standings from all conference athletic events. The archives section contains so much information!! Previous stats books are also posted on the site.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, as well as the website, I hope that it will help you remember the players, coaches, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference boys' basketball. See ya.
