#### FREE THROWING (MISCELLANEOUS)

There were 895 free throws attempted this season (compared to 1,030 attempts last season—a 13.1% decrease in free throws attempted). 351 of those free throws were converted (compared to 362 last season—a 3.0% decrease in converted free throws). This season's free throw conversion percentage is .392 (compared to .351 last season).
