Normally, to compare this season's totals with last year's, I would double last season's totals. #### FIRST QUARTER

There were 937 points scored during the first quarter of all games this season (compared to 610 points scored in the first quarter last season—a 1.3% decrease\* in the points scored in the first quarter). 23.0% of all points were scored in the first quarter (compared to 24.3% last season). There was an average of 16.7 points scored by both teams in the first quarter (compared to 16.9 points last season). The team that outscored their opponent in the first quarter won the game 73.6% of the time.
