

FOREWORD

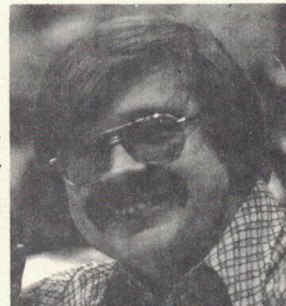

STATISTICIAN'S NOTE

This season, due to the fact that Washington did not compete in girls' basketball, the conference played a different amount of games (16 less) than were played last season.

For this reason, it is impossible to compare this season's stats with those of last year. I, therefore, computed the average statistic from last season and prorated that number to create a total that could be used for comparison. Seasonal increases or decreases that have been affected are denoted with an asterisk ().*

I feel that this is the only way that a true comparison of the two seasons is possible.
