FOREWORD

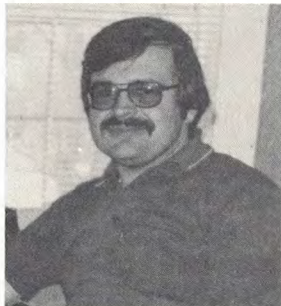
