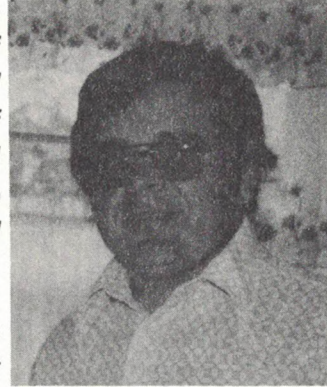

Not to be forgotten are the Dollies from Derham Hall who won the Region 3AA title and, thus, became the second City Conference entrant to play in the 1982 tournament.*
