FOREWORD

The tenth season of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball is over. And as I have for each of those ten years, I present to you my statistical report. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding. I hope you appreciate the time, effort and pride that I have placed in this and past statistical endeavors.



This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. Special thanks to Bill Lynch, Clare Longsdorf and Dale Carmichael for their extra efforts. Without the help of all that I have mentioned, this report could never have been produced.

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the St. Paul City Conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some sort of recognition (which all players and coaches need and deserve) and to give special recognition to those that excel in a particular category. One must always remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

This season could be called the year of the record. 14 conference records were tied or broken. Derham Hall ended Hill-Murray's three year reign as conference champion, finishing with a perfect 14-0 mark. The Tom Cody coached Dollies then won the Twin Cities title, Region 3AA crown, and a respectable fifth place finish in the State Tournament. Highland Park broke Hill-Murray's 42 game conference winning streak, the second longest in City Conference basketball history (Central's boys' team won 45 straight). Hill-Murray shattered the single-game scoring record by tallying 106 points. Individual scoring also saw many record setters....seven times players scored 30 or more points (in the previous nine years only six players had broken into the thirties)....Dorie Adamez of Humboldt broke the single-game scoring record with 41 points....Harding's Ann Schultz won the scoring title with the highest average ever (21.8)....three players averaged over twenty points (previously only two players had ever averaged more than 20 points)....two players climbed into the All-Time top ten scorers list: Ann Schultz moved into a tie for seventh with her 590 career points, and Johnson's Patty Lake leaped into third place with a career total at 678 and is virtually assured of breaking the career scoring record next year. Good luck, Patty.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember that players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference girls' basketball, 1983-1984. See ya.
