## FOREWORD

*The 13th season of St. Paul City Conference Girls' Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season and past seasons. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding.*

*This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!*

*As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling statistics for the conference has always been to give every player and coach some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.*

*With less games played this year (each team played only ten games compared to 14 last year) it is impossible to directly compare this year's stats with last year's. I therefore used a percentage of the average statistic to compensate for the games lost. Seasonal increases/decreases that are affected are noted with an asterisk (\*). I feel this is the only way a true comparison of the two seasons is possible.*

*One of this season's highlights was Highland Park's Tracy Buckman scoring 38 points (against Harding). This was the second highest for an individual ever in the conference. Dorie Adamez scored a conference record 41 points in 1984. This was Hill-Murray's last year of participation in the conference and they went out in a blaze of glory, copping the City Conference crown along with the Twin Cities title. The Bill Wold coached Pioneers went on to win Region 4AA laurels and took fourth place honors in the State Tournament (their two State Tourney losses were both by a single point). I think everyone will agree that Hill-Murray's presence in the conference both strengthened and provided tougher competition for all teams. In their ten years of City Conference play, they won or shared six conference titles; posting a 126-12 record (91.3%). An impressive record, indeed! Best of luck to the Pioneers in the new Twin Cities Conference!*
