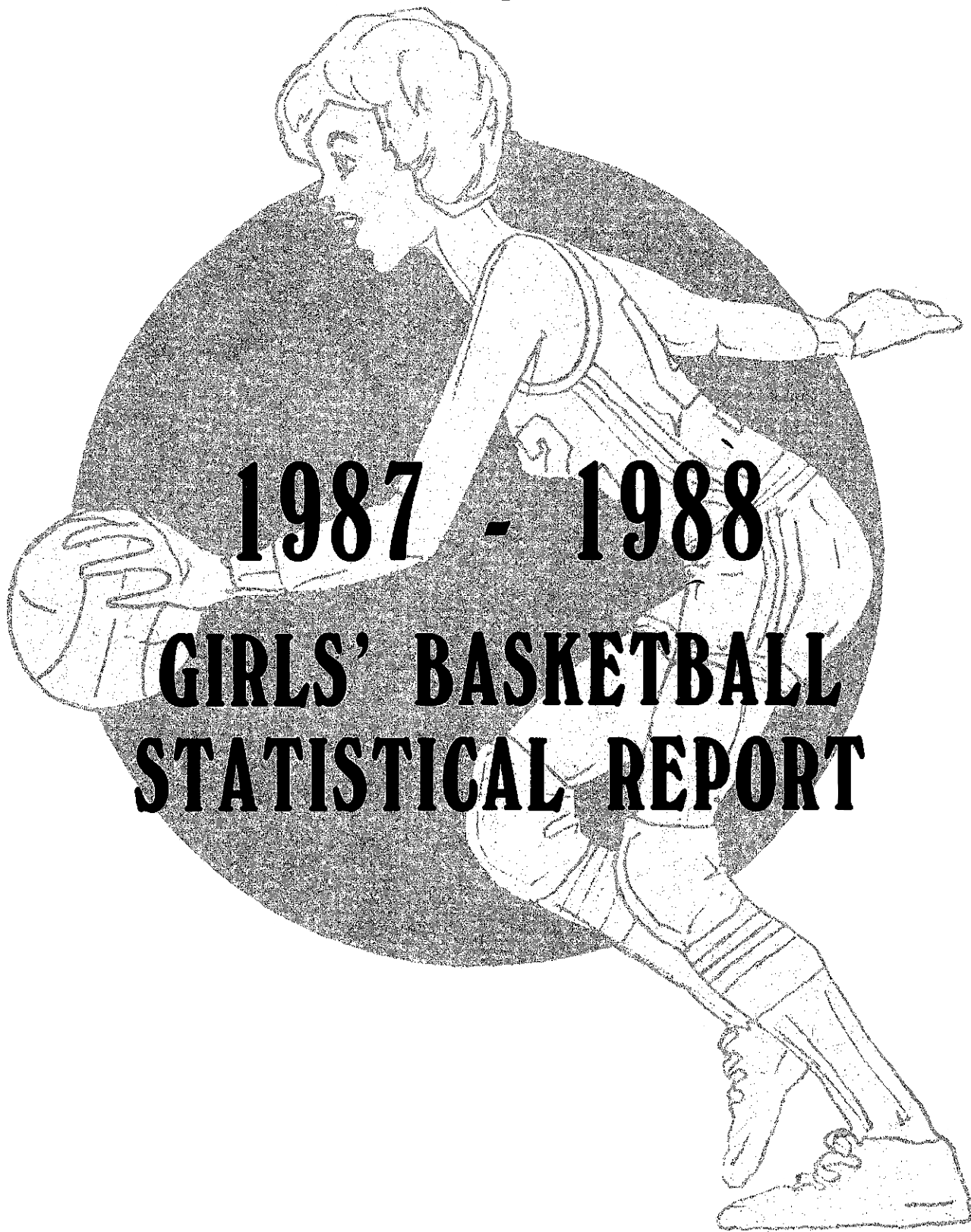

FOREWORD

The 14th season of St. Paul City Conference Girls' Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 100 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible! For the first time ever, a school (Central) did not return the forms, forcing other schools to produce an extra game summary sheet. I apologize for the tardiness in getting you this report but, unfortunately, I did not receive the final game sheet until May 20th.

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling stats for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

With more games played this season (due to Hill-Murray's departure and the return to the double round-robin schedule), it is impossible to directly compare this season's stats with those of last year. I computed the average statistic from last season and pro-rated that number to create a total that could be used for comparison sake. Seasonal increases/decreases that have been affected are noted with an asterisk ().*

This season Harding rolled through the conference undefeated and in the process set several conference records (most points in a game -- 115; highest average points per game -- 81.6; and largest average differential in score -- 47.6 points). The Tom Gunderson coached Knights went on to capture Twin Cities game honors and then the Region 3AA title. Although they lost both games in the State Tournament, the Knights were the first team ever in the State Tournament to score a three-point basket. Margaret Nowlin of Cretin-Derham Hall ended her City Conference career by winning an unprecedented third straight scoring title. Her conference career total of 752 points vaulted her into fourth place on the all-time conference scoring list. All in all, another exciting year in the St. Paul City Conference.



As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference Girls' Basketball. See ya!
