FOREWORD

The 17th season of St. Paul City Conference Girl's Basketball is now history. You were part of that history. My annual report is a look at the statistics of the just-completed season, as well as past seasons. It is the culmination of over 50 hours of compilation, typing, mimeographing and binding.

This report is, by no means, the effort of just one individual. My thanks go to every coach, assistant coach and scorer that assisted in submitting the game summary sheets. You made this report possible!

As I have stressed in previous reports, my sole objective in compiling stats for the conference has always been to give every player and coach in the conference some well-deserved recognition and to give special honor to those that excel in a particular category. Remember that a player's ability cannot, and should not, be measured solely on her statistics.

This season Harding roared through the conference with an unblemished 12-0 mark. The Knights scored 108 points against Como Park, the second highest total ever. In the process, Harding averaged 83.5 points per game in the conference; defeating its opponents by an average of 48.7 points (both records). The Tom Gunderson coached Knights defeated Minneapolis Roosevelt for the Twin Cities

crown (marking the thirteenth time out of sixteen games that St. Paul has prevailed). Harding continued its march by winning the Region 3AA title and finished fifth in the State Tournament (losing to eventual State Champion St. Louis Park in the first round). During the conference season, the Knights produced the top three scorers in the conference, a fete never achieved before in the conference. Leading Harding was its super scorer Shannon Loeblein. To list all of the records that she broke would surely fill this page. To capsulize, Shannon scored 330 points for the season (44 in one game) averaging an incredible 27.5 points per



game (all records, of course). She now has 639 career conference points, just 241 shy of Patty Lake's all-time career mark. And with one year still remaining in her career, she has already placed her name among the all-time greats of the conference. Congratulations to Shannon and her Harding Knight teammates.

As you peruse the pages of this and previous reports, I hope that it will help you remember the players, teams and records of St. Paul City Conference Girl's Basketball. See ya!

A FINAL WORD

This past season a City Conference basketball coach endured torment and tribulation not generally associated with the problems a coach encounters. Overzealous parents that thought they could judge the talent of their child better than a coach with almost 20 years of experience in both evaluating and training young athletes -- it involved the cutting of a player from a team.

It went beyond the verbal and mental harassment that the coach endured -- he was subjected to litigation and slanderous racial innuendos in the print media. It went so far as the grandfather of the player in question appealing to his fellow school board members; trying to use his influence on the school board to reinstate the player. It's too bad that this now former school board member chose to direct his energy on a personal issue rather than solving the problems of the school district that he was elected.

In my opinion this entire episode was very simple to rule on: it wasn't a black issue or a white issue. It was a stupid issue. One that, fortunately, our judicial system concurred with and upheld the coach's decision to cut the player.

Let's hope that other coaches in the future will not be subjected to this same type of parental harassment.
